D3.3 Success rate in supervision of PhD students

The Institute of Psychology has an agreement on joint education of doctoral students with two faculties of the Masaryk University (the Faculty of Arts and the Faculty of Social Studies), but not with the Charles University. An ongoing cooperation with the Faculty of Arts at Charles University is based on sharing the Laboratory of Behavioural and Linguistic Studies (LABELS). We are planning to sign additional agreements about joint education of doctoral students with faculties of the Charles University to have a better access to doctoral students in Prague in the future.
